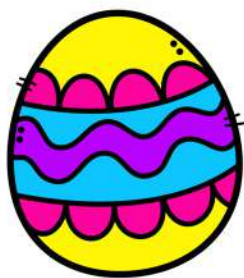
Hop hop hop. I'm not under

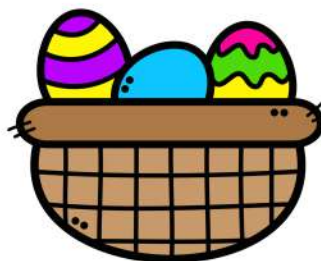
The Easter bunny likes to leave eggs.
